

Fabric Painting is a very interesting hobby and passion that one can inculcate. There are professionals who specialise in fabric painting in a big way commercially. It's been an initiative and a breakthrough on our part here at Pidilite to have launched out new range of Fevicryl Fabric Colours that are ideal and apt to be used on fabrics.

The Fevicryl Fabric colours are bright, bold and they are versatile on fabric/s. The colours are water based and absolutely safe for children as they are non toxic in nature.

Fabric painting can be successful only if you use the correct kind and type of fabric. The nature and properties of Fabric colours make it apt for fabric no doubt but choosing the right fabric is important. Fabric colours are perfect and best on materials such as cotton, khadi and silk as they are natural fibre fabrics.

There are few important key specifics that one needs to keep in mind while painting on fabric materials. Here are few pointers; A tightly woven fabric when painted on will give you a very smooth kind of a finish. Similarly, a loose fabric can nevertheless be painted but requires a specific kind of technique. The higher the thread count of a fabric the better would be the final resultant.

Another very vital aspect that needs to be kept in mind is, how a fabric needs to be prepared prior to painting. Firstly, a fabric needs to be pre washed so that if there is scope of shrinkage in it, it would be over with and if any starch present that too would be washed off. Secondly, the fabric would have to be dried and ironed.

Once these things are done on a fabric, your base material is now ready to be painted with Fabric Colours. synthetic fabrics now, they normally do not absorb colours as they are made of polymers and the paint would merely sit atop the fabric. Having said that Fevicryl Fabric Paints work well on synthetic fabrics, provided the fabric has no sheen or an oily finish. Washable, natural fibres and blends are the best fabrics to be worked on with Fabric paints.

#### **OBJECTIVE AND COURSE DESIGN**

The Certificate holder will acquire the required skills over a period of time in fabric paintingthe teaching will be divided into 80% practical component and 20% theory component. Mentor should note that the Certificate programme is to lay full stress on practical aspects as reflected in the ratio mentioned above. The primary purpose of the programme is to enable the students to focus on a particular set of working skills which should lead to a vocation or employment.

As per the orders of the Government cited in the 1<sup>st</sup> reference, there shall be mandatory internship for all UG programmes for 10 months – 1st Internship (Community Service Project) after the end of 2nd semester examinations, 2nd Apprenticeship/ Internship / On the Job Training after the end of 4th semester examinations and the 3rd and final Apprenticeship / Internship / On the Job Training in 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> semester to ensure that the students develop hands on technical skills which will be of great help in facing the world of work along with developing social consciousness and compassionate commitment towards the neighbourhood.

Community Service Project is an experiential learning strategy that integrates meaningful community service with instruction, participation, learning and community development. Community Service Project involves students in community development and service activities and applies the experience to personal and academic development. Community Service Project is meant to link the community with the college for mutual benefit. The community will be benefited with the focused contribution of the college students for the village/ local development. The college finds an opportunity to develop social sensibility and responsibility among students and also emerge as a socially responsible institution.

The following Standard Operating Procedure shall be followed for the implementation of Community Service Project (1<sup>st</sup> Internship) in all Government Degree Colleges in the state duly following the Guidelines given by APSCHE vide reference no.2 cited.

## Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Community Service Project (1st Internship)

### I Duration:

The Community Service Project shall be held after the completion of 2nd semester examinations, i.e during intervening summer of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and 3<sup>rd</sup> semester for the duration of 4 weeks (100 Hours). For the students who are admitted in first year for the academic year 2021-22, the Community Service Project can be done anytime during III to VI semesters, including on weekends or holidays, completing the mandatory 4 weeks as per the APSCHE Guideline - Corrigendum cited vide reference no.3.

#### II Schedule:

- Socio-Economic Survey of the Village/Habitation (One weeks)
- Community awareness campaign (One week)
- Main Project Implementation (One week)
- Project Report writing (One week)

### III Implementation of the CSP:

- · A group of students or even a single student could be assigned for a particular habitation or village or municipal ward, as far as possible, in the near vicinity of their place of stay, so as to enable them to commute from their residence and return back by evening or so.
  - Each faculty member is to be assigned with a class/ section/ group of 10 to15 students depending upon availability of the faculty members. The faculty member will act as a faculty-mentor for the group and is in-charge for the learning activities of the students and also for the comprehensive and continuous assessment of the students.
    - All the Regular, Contract, Guest faulty shall be involved in CSP as faculty mentor for a group of students.
    - The Community Service Project should be different from the regular programmes of NSS/NCC/Green Corps/Red Ribbon Club, etc in an adopted village. Students shall be given choice to take up CSP in the habitation or village or municipal ward of their own choice/convenience.
    - The Community Service Project is a twofold one -
      - First, the student/s could conduct a survey of the habitation, if necessary, in terms of their own domain or subject area. For ex., a

and about the Government's social security schemes. A student of Sciences could take up a survey on the health and hygiene conditions of that habitation, similarly, with other subject areas too. Or it can even be a general survey, incorporating all the different areas. A common survey format could be designed. This should not be viewed as a duplication of work by the Village or Ward volunteers; rather, it could be another primary source of data.

Secondly, the student/s could take up a project work related to their domain or subject area.

#### IV Role of the Teacher/Mentor:

- a) The faculty mentor shall provide necessary orientation and training for the students on methodology for survey, preparation of questionnaire, maintenance of Log Book, Project report and writing etc.,
- b) To assign a village/ habitation/ municipal ward to each student as per the choice of the student/convenience.
- c) To guide the students in conducting socio economic Survey in the assigned village/ habitation/ municipal ward.
- d) To guide the students to take up Community awareness campaign/special camps and to act as resource person when required.
- e) To verify and countersign the Log Book of each student
- f) To guide the students in implementation of the project and Project report.
- g) To evaluate the project and award the grade based on the active participation of the student as per the assessment methodology

#### V Procedure:

## 1. Socio-Economic Survey of the Village/Habitation - log book

A group of students under the guidance of faculty mentors conduct a Socioeconomic Survey of the Village/habitation. They will interact with people to acquire basic knowledge on the project chosen for study and conduct the survey using a structured questionnaire.

### 2. Community awareness campaign

The students group takes up community awareness campaigns based on the above survey conducted by identifying the problems or vulnerable issues. They may also conduct house to house campaign on socially relevant theme. Ex: Government welfare programs, health care, consumer protection, food adulteration, digital transactions, information sources, etc.

#### 3. Project Implementation

A group of students choose a topic related to their subject area and conduct a Project which includes, Data collection, interviews, internship in any select unit or department.

#### 4. Project Report

The student should submit a project report duly signed by the mentor.

## VI Assessment Methodology:

- There will be only internal evaluation for CSP internship.

#### ORDER:-

In the G.O. 1<sup>st</sup> read above, permission was accorded to the State funded Universities in the State of Andhra Pradesh for introduction of four (4) year Honours Programmes with ten (10) months of mandatory internship.

- 2. In the e-file 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Secretary, A.P. State Council of Higher Education has submitted that the AP State Council of Higher Education constituted Committees to redesign the curriculum framework of all UG Conventional and Professional (Engineering) Programmes and based on the recommendations of the Committees and the vision of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, a thoroughly revised curriculum with Life Skill Courses, Skill Development Courses and Skill Enhancement Courses in conventional degree programmes and skill courses in major and minor electives and skill enhancement electives in Engineering programmes was introduced from the Academic Year 2020–21. The unique feature of the revised curriculum is a 10 month mandatory Service Project was an integral part.
- 3. The mandatory 10 month internship is done in three phases. In the first phase, the 2-month Community Service Project shall be mandatorily done by all students during the intervening summer vacation between the first and second years of study and in the second phase a 2-month internship/apprenticeship/on the job training shall be mandatorily done by all the students during the final and third phase a 6-month (one full semester) internship/apprenticeship/on the job training shall be done mandatorily either in the 5th Semester or 6th performance.

In case of 4-year Professional Degree Programmes, in the first phase, the mandatory 2-month Community Service Project shall be done by all students during the intervening summer vacation between the second and third years of study and in the second phase a mandatory 2-month all the students during the intervening summer vacation between the third and fourth years of study. In the final and third phase a 6-month of the shall be done mandatorily either in the 7th Semester or 8th Semester

4. In this background, Government after examination of the matter hereby issue the following guidelines for the 10 month mandatory internship/apprenticeship/on the job training for all the 3/4 year Conventional Degree Programmes, 5-year Integrated PG programmes and to the 4-year Professional programmes from the Academic Year 2020-21:-

## 1. Community Service Project:

The Community Service Project is an experiential learning strategy that integrates meaningful community service with instruction, participation. development. and community Community Project involves students in community development and service activities and applies the experience to personal and academic development. Community Service Project is meant to link the community with the college for mutual benefit. The community will be benefited with the focused contribution of the college students for the village/ local development. The college finds an opportunity to develop social sensibility and responsibility among students and also emerge as a socially responsible institution. The community service project has to be undertaken as per the guidelines of A.P. State Council of Higher Education and with the approval of respective Universities

## 2. Internship/Apprenticeship/On the Job Training

Developing an internship policy is an impactful strategy for creating a future talent pool for the industry. The Internship program not only helps fresh pass-outs in gaining professional know-how but also benefits the employers on fresh perspectives on business issues and even discovering potential future business leaders. The main aim of this initiative is enhancement of the employability skills of the students passing out from Higher Educational Institutions. The A.P. State Council of Higher Education has prepared a revised CBCS curriculum with the help of prominent academicians so that the State of Andhra Pradesh may produce competent employable graduates as per the needs of the industries. The objectives, procedures and evaluation system are defined in the regulations of the revised CBCS curriculum as approved by the respective Universities.

3. The 10-month mandatory community service / internship / apprenticeship/on the job training is an initiative which is unique in the country and also highly challenging. The community service / internship / apprenticeship / on the job training opportunity has to be provided to all the students of higher education at different phases of their study as per the regulations. To facilitate internships and also to implement them effectively an administrative mechanism is necessary at each district level.

In order to ensure effective implementation of the mandatory 10-month internship for the students of Colleges and Universities, and on the recommendation of the A.P. State Council of Higher Education, the Government of Andhra Pradesh constitutes State Level and district level internship coordination committees in each of the districts of Andhra Pradesh with immediate effect. The composition, roles and responsibilities of the committees are as described hereunder:

The tenure of the nominated members shall be for a period of three years from the date of nomination.

#### 3.4 Role and responsibilities of the District Level Committees:

- 3.4.1 Conducting meetings of the committee for a minimum of two times in a year. Once before the start of the academic year.
- 3.4.2 Conducting meetings with the local industrialists, service organisations, Government departments, agencies and other professionals, to explore the possibilities of the internship/ apprenticeship /on the job training in the respective organizations and establishments.
- 3.4.3 Explore the possibilities of vacancies for internship / apprenticeship /on the job training in various organizations and industries/ establishments, both in public and private and in Central and State Government Departments and empanel professionals/small business establishments and other agencies which can offer internships.
- 3.4.4 To ensure the implementation of the provisions of Apprenticeship Act wherever applicable.
- 3.4.5 To review periodically the effectiveness of internship programme in consultation with all the stakeholders. To ensure that all the students are provided with internships preferably as per their interests and domain of study.

#### 3.5. Roles and Responsibilities of the Registrars of the Universities:

- 3.5.1. Liaison between the colleges under the jurisdiction of the University concerned and the District Coordination Committee.
- 3.5.2. To finalize the guidelines for the allotment of students to various organizations.
- 3.5.3. To submit the demand for internships in different fields of study to the committee as and when required-
- 3.5.4. To prepare the lists of students participating in the internship/apprenticeship/on the job training, including in the community service project.
- 3.5.5. To prepare the student-demand analysis.
- 3.5.6. To prepare a list of students who are prepared to do the internship outside the district and to find suitable organizations and establishments.
- 3.5.7. To map the students and the internship offering establishments and organizations
- 3.5.8. To provide data and information to the committee as required by the committee
- 5. The Registrars of the Universities in the State of Andhra Pradesh shall adopt the above orders with the approval of their respective Statutory Boards for its implementation of the aforesaid orders in all the Universities, Colleges and its affiliated colleges under their jurisdiction from the Academic Year 2020-21.

The Collectors and District Magistrates shall take further action in the matter accordingly.

There is 2 Month Internship (Short-Term Internship) after the 4<sup>th</sup> Semester and a 6 Month Internship (Semester-Wise Internship) during the 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> Semester.

The following Standard Operating Procedure shall be followed for the implementation of Short-Term Internship and Semester-Term Internship in all Government Degree Colleges in the state duly following the Guidelines given by APSCHE vide reference(2), (4) and (5) cited.

# Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Internship

(On-site/Virtual)

#### Objectives:

- To develop communication, interpersonal and other critical thinking skills required in the future job.
- To acquire additional skills required for the world of work.
- To acquire employment contacts leading directly to a full-time job following graduation
- · To provide the work place skills

#### Learning outcomes:

After the Internship, the students will

- Integrate theory and practice.
- Develop work habits and attitudes necessary for job success.
- Build a record of work experience.
- Acquire additional skills required for the world of work.

### Internship Types:

- 1. Short-Term Internship
- Semester-Term Internship

#### Duration:

- The Short-Term Internship: 2 Months.
- The Semester-Term Internship: 6 months.

#### Schedule:

- > The Short-Term Internship: After the completion of the 4th Semester End
- The Semester-Term Internship: During the 5th or 6th Semester based on the affiliated

## Responsibilities of the Principal:

- 1. The Principals should identify the Regular, Contract and Guest Lecturers as the Mentors and mapping the students with the mentors.
- 2. Each faculty member is to be mapped with a minimum of 15 students. The maximum number of students for mapping depends upon the availability of the number of faculty
- 3. The principal shall be monitoring the activities of the students as well as mentors from

## Responsibilities of the Mentors:

- 1. The mentor shall identify the industries.
- 2. The mentor may divide their mapped students into batches based on Industry or based on
- 3. The mentor shall map the student to the Industry based on the specialization of the
- 4. The mentor should regularly interact with the students through Whatsapp or Phonecalls and clear their doubts regarding the Internship.
- The mentor should monitor their mapped students using I-MAP.
- 6. Using I-MAP, The mentor should assign weekly tasks to their mapped students and should validate the log book regularly.

#### Responsibilities of the Students:

- 1. The student should undergo the Internship, which is assigned by the college.
- The student should complete the tasks before the deadline assigned by the mentor and trainer.
- 3. The student should submit their assigned tasks by the deadline through the I-MAP.
- 4. Students must make their own arrangements of transportation to reach the industry.
- The student should maintain punctuality in attending the internship and follow the rules and regulations of the Industry.
- The student should learn about the industry, policies, procedures, and processes by interacting with their trainer.
- 7. While in the intern industry, always wear your College Identity Card.
- Practice professional communication skills with team members, co-interns and the supervisor. This includes expressing thoughts and ideas effectively through oral, written and non-verbal communication, and utilizing listening skills.
- The student should regularly fill out their Program Book, the Activity log and the weekly reports with their handwriting.
- 10. Student should never cause any disturbance to the regular activities of the industry.

#### **Execution Process:**

#### 1. Mapping of Mentors:

- The college Principal should identify all the lecturers as mentors.
- The Principal will map the mentors to the students.

#### 2. Industry Connect:

- The Principal and lecturers will identify the industries in the district. For the
  identification of the industry, they may take the help of district collectors and/or the
  industries listed in the Industry Connect Portal of the <a href="http://apcce.gov.in">http://apcce.gov.in</a> website.
- After the identification of the industry, the mentor will contact the industry for the Internships.
- The principal and mentors should ensure that the industry is a safe zone for the students.

## 3. Internship Offer and Acceptance:

The organization offers the internship to a candidate, who then accepts the offer. The
organization and the intern should then sign a formal agreement to establish the terms and
conditions of the internship.

### 4. Internship Objectives:

The organization and the intern should establish clear objectives for the internship. This
may include specific tasks and responsibilities, as well as goals for the intern's
professional development.

#### 5. Internship Plan:

- The organization should develop a detailed plan for the internship, including the intern's schedule, tasks and responsibilities, and any required training.
- The plan should be reviewed and approved by both the organization and the intern.

## 6. Supervision and Mentorship:

- The organization should assign a supervisor or mentor to the intern to provide guidance and support throughout the internship.
- The supervisor or mentor should be available to the intern on a regular basis and provide regular feedback and guidance.

7. Internship Mapping:

 After the acceptance of the industries for Internships to the college, the mentors should For Short-term Internships, the students from all specialization are eligible for virtual mode Internship. Whereas for Semester-Term Internships, only the students from the

specialization of computers are eligible for virtual mode Internship.

## 8. Pre-Internship:

- Before the student will undergo the Internship, the Principal and the mentor should guide
  - the student for the following: a. How to fill out the program book?

- c. What are the instructions given to the students by APSCHE, CCE and Affiliated University?, etc.
- d. What are the Internship norms of the Industry?
- For Short-term Internship, the student will undergo 2 months Internship in the mapped industry. For Semester-term Internship, the student will undergo 6 months Internship in the mapped industry.

### 9. Tasks & Monitoring:

• The Principal, mentor and trainer should monitor the student with I-MAP.

The mentor assigns weekly tasks to the students. The student should submit their task on or before the next week Monday.

• The mentor should verify the student's task and give the grade within 3 days of the next week of the task assigned week.

## 11. Internship Completion:


