

ACADEMIC COUNCIL 2018-19

Action taken report 2018-19(based on the resolutions passed in the Academic Council meeting Dt: 30-06-2018)

1. The Autonomous status is implemented for the existing UG courses
2. Implemented the approved syllabus of different Boards of Studies for the Academic Year 2018-19.
3. Out of three certificate courses two are implemented.
4. The college could not implement the course as the CCE, the coordinating authority, has not given the instructions to the effect.
5. Implemented CBCS as per norms of the University and UGC.
6. The approved Academic Calendar was implemented during the year 2018-19.
7. Implemented projects as assessment method in one cluster subject in semester 6 under external evaluation.
8. Implemented Telugu medium in the necessary FC Courses in BA and B.Sc programmes.
9. Implemented award of additional credits for outstanding performance in extracurricular activities and for 100% attendance.
10. Implemented minimum attendance requirement in the following way:
Condonation fee is collected in the following scales giving benefit to the poor students
 - Minimum of Rs 300/- for all scales
 - Between 70-75% an amount of Rs 20/- per day of absence.
 - Between 60-70% an amount of Rs 30/- per day of absence.
 - Between 50-60% an amount of Rs 40/- per day of absence.
11. Implemented the conduct of 70 marks of external and 30 marks of internal for first and third year students and 60 marks external and 40 marks internal for second year students.
 - Open Book examination on pilot basis was conducted in the departments of zoology and Telugu and 60% of the students gave positive feedback.
12. Implemented the computation of Grades for each semester.
13. Implemented moderation and grafting of marks.
14. Implemented the approved expenditure on BOS, AC and COE.
15. Implemented the College and Library timings
16. Reconstituted the Autonomous Statutory Bodies
