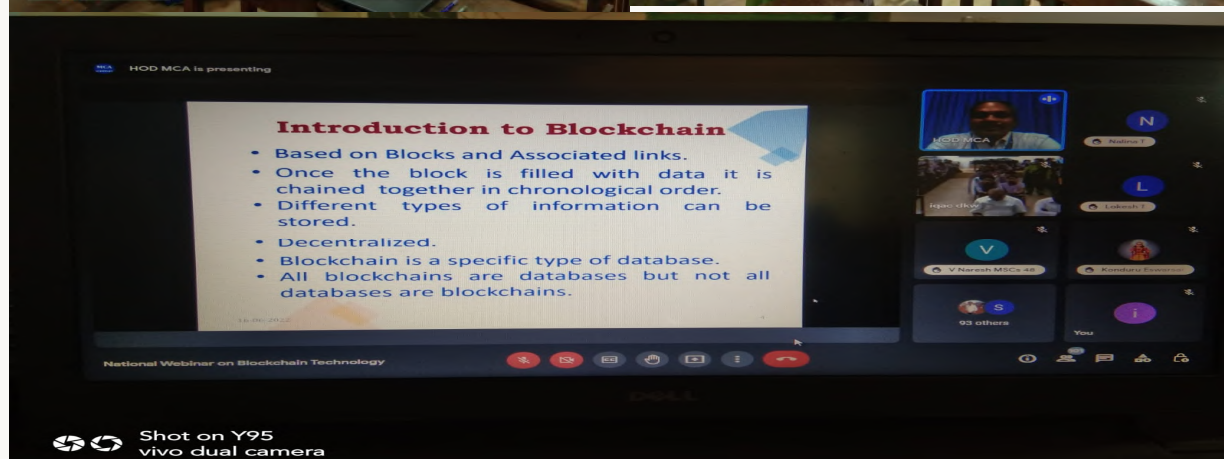

During these classes, Yoga experts are invited from outside to give valuable speeches related to health and hygiene, stress bustering, long term memory and so on. G.Srinivas and Dr.M.Venkata Krishna, Rainbow Kids Hospital attended the classes and delivered lectures on “ Decision Making” and upkeeping of health.

YRC - First Aid Training from 20-06-2022 to 22-06-2022

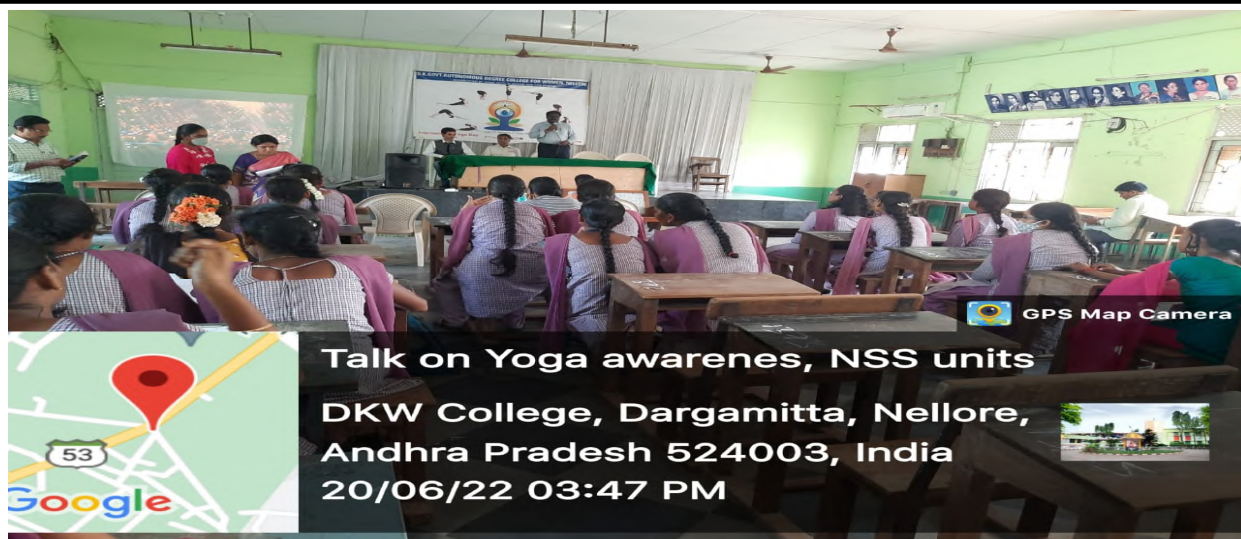

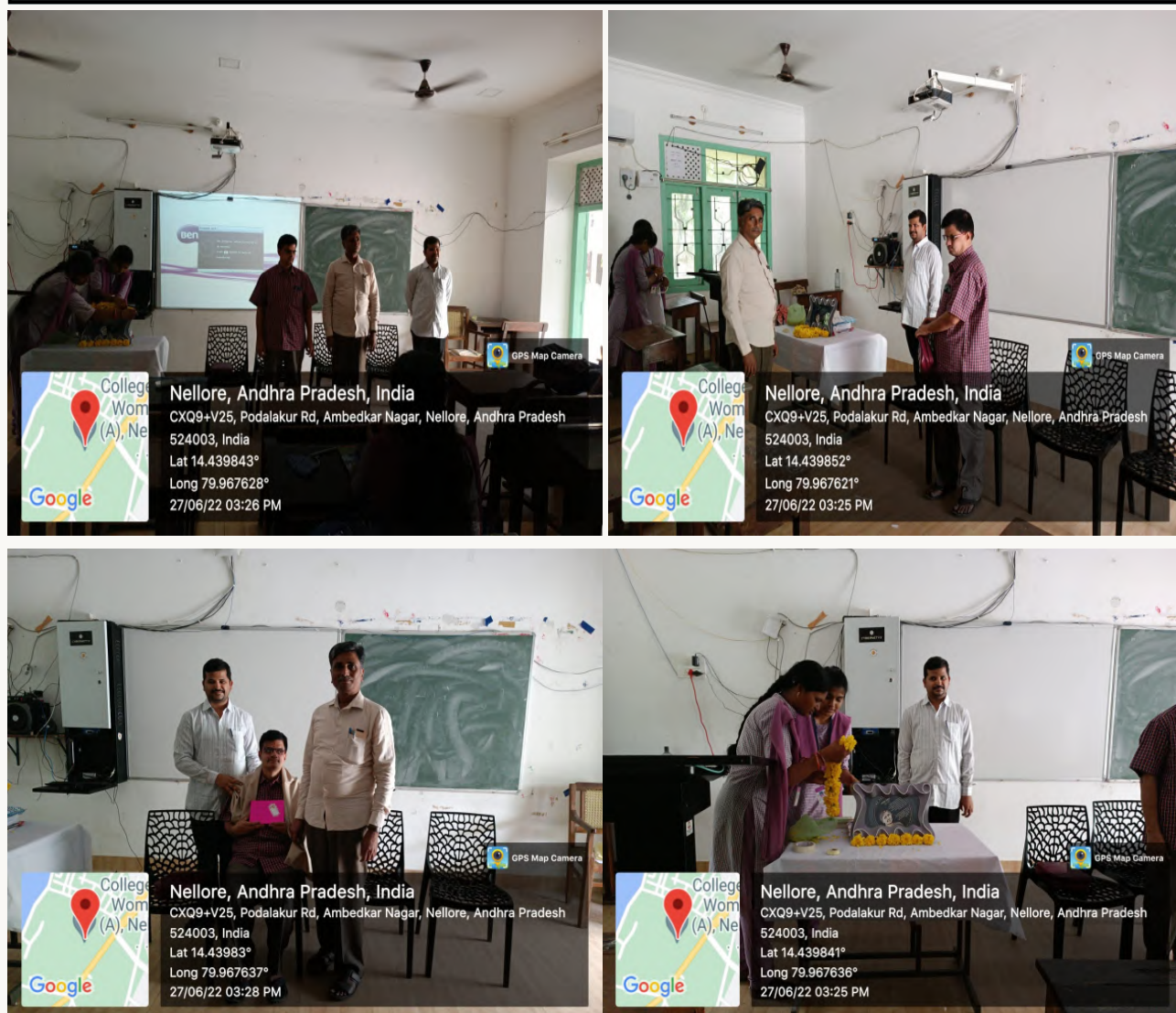
