



WOMEN EQUALITY DAY

Women and gender sensitization committee was constituted in our college to create awareness for the students, staff and other administrative staff free from harassment or gender-based discrimination. As our college is women institution, this committee empowers women that create a healthy relationship in the society.

The programme has been organized in D. K. Govt. College for women on 26th August 2017 to give awareness to the students about women rights. Principal Dr C.H. Masthanaiah sir presided over the programme and the chief guest Dr Pallumreddy Yashodhara garu enlightened the students about the equal opportunities to education and employment, pushing against the suppression and violence towards women and against the discrimination.

Nearly 300 students involved in this programme and teaching and non-teaching staff also participated.



MOTIVATION AND AWARENESS SESSION IN SELF DEFENCE

An awareness and motivational session in defence has been conducted on 6th September 2017 for the students in association with the district police authorities. The Principal of the college Dr C.H. Masthanaiah sir presided over the programme. The chief guest of the programme Sri N.B.K.Muralikrishna DSP, Nellore district addressed the students about the need for being aware of the strategies of self defence. Nellore town CI Sri Narasimha Reddy sir told the students about the mental agility that students have to possess at the time of emergency situations. He asserted that it is not just mental strength but mental alertness that helps one in saving oneself from evil elements.

Two of the members from Durga academy namely V. Ravi and N. Lakshmi displayed the tactics for self defence that students can use in case of their being assaulted physically. Nearly 325 students were made to practice the tips.




RISK EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME


The programme was conducted in our college on 12th March 2018 and Dr C. H. Masthanaiah, Principal of the college presided over the function.

An awareness programme on gender equality was conducted by Dr C. Kalapriya, Lecturer in Home science on 21st October 2018 about the different views of gender equality such as Psychological and Sociological. She highlighted that the socially acceptable ways of acting out gender norms are learned from birth through childhood socialization. The students learned about what the parents teaches as well as what we pick up at school through religious or cultural teachings in the media and various other social institutions. She also focussed that gender is pervasive dichotomy that guides the behaviour.


More than 40 students from different subjects attended the programme and gained the knowledge on the views of gender equality.

CLARITY ON GENDER DISPARITY

The lecture on gender disparity in workplace was described by Dr. C. Kalapriya, Lecturer in Home science on 30th October 2018 in Room No. 50 at D. K. Govt. college for Women, Nellore. She has focussed several issues on gender disparity. She addressed many components in gender disparity where women are facing the obstacles at workplace. As the working women are expected to balance two jobs simultaneously- one at the working place and another at the home, women are facing so many problems like no support with the family members at home to comply with the timings at the workplace, taking care of children etc. Women are much more likely than men to work in service occupations like personal care aides, home health aides, nursing assistants and other roles that include a gentle touch. The need to implement policies that can effectively increase the pace of change of women to improve within the workplace is utmost important.

Further she added that learning the strategies to improve and effective use of resources could considerably help in overcoming gender disparity at workplace. Nearly 30 students attended the lecture from various disciplines. The students motivated themselves and also imparted knowledge to the girls residing at welfare hostels in Nellore district.


The Theme for 2021 Human Rights is: EQUALITY - Reducing inequalities, advancing human rights. This programme was aimed to spread the awareness of human rights among students. The Principal of our college Dr. D. Giri sir presided over the function. The Chief guests were Sri. Sri Mannarayana, SETNEL officer, Sri. Vijay Kumar, Voluntary organiser, Sri. A Mahendar Reddy, Nehru Yuva Kendra officer, Sri. Abdul Khayum, District skill development officer, LawerRamyarekha, Assistant Professor. D. Rama Devi participated in the program.

The speakers focussed on the Human rights and enlightened the students about the right to be free from torture, the right to freedom of expression, the right to education and the right to civil and political rights, such as the rights to life, liberty and privacy. One of the speaker explained that UDHR also mentions economic, social and cultural rights, such as the rights to social security, health and affordable housing. Finally it was concluded that the Universal Declaration of Human Rights sets out a broad range of fundamental rights and freedoms to which all of us are entitled. Students were very much interested and had an interactive session at the end of the program.

The voters' awareness day held on 25th January2021 made the students and employees think about the value of vote and its proper utilisation.
